

Sept. 24, 2024 - Open Subject: Competition open to all images. Post-processing allows for removal of distracting features, e.g., a limb of a tree or a passerby on the edge. However, no new images from another photo e.g., clouds in the sky, can be added.

Oct. 22, 2024 - Leading Lines – A photo that captures an image that naturally draws your eye towards a specific point of interest.



Nov. 26, 2024 - Faces: One or more human or animals faces.

Examples:



Jan. 28, 2025 – Open: Open Subject –Unrestrictive. [SEE, definitions for 2023-24]

Feb. 25, 2025 - Travel: An image beyond 50 miles of Leisure World that portrays the land, buildings, people, or culture in its natural (not posed) state. This does not include images of the act or mode of traveling, e.g., inside an airplane or a train crossing a bridge.

Examples:



March 25, 2025 – Cityscape: An image that captures urban landscapes, i.e. manmade features like streets and tall buildings are the focus of cityscape photography.

April 22, 2025 – End of Year: Up to three (3) images recognized by a judge in the 2024-25 competition.

Sept. 2025 – **Open Subject:** Competition open to all images. Post-processing allows for removal of distracting features, e.g., a limb of a tree or a passerby on the edge. However, no new images from another photo, e.g., clouds in the sky, can be added.

Oct. 2025 – **Public Interiors:** Any indoor space intended for public use and/or enjoyment.







Nov. 2025 – **Montgomery County:** Any images taken in Montgomery County, especially those images that reflect objects and places that are known to be in the county.



Jan. 2026- Open Subject: Advanced techniques allowed, unrestrictive.

Every item of the image must be from the submitting photographer.

Feb. 2026-Transportation: Image should depict movement of goods, or one or more persons.









March 2026-Street and Public Art: May include printings and/or sculptures as the main subject. The art must be in a public place; however, museum pieces are not included




April 2026-End of Year: Up to three images (3) recognized by a judge in the 2025-26 competitions.

Sept. 2026—**Open Subject:** Competition open to all images. Post-processing allows for removal of distracting features, e.g., a limb of a tree or a passerby on the edge. No new images from another photo, e.g., clouds in the sky, can be added.

Oct. 2026—Still Life:



Jan. 2027—Open

Subject: Advanced techniques allowed,

e.g., adding clouds in the sky or cars on a highway. Techniques that add new image elements not in the original image photographed by the member are prohibited, including applying textures or incorporating components (such as skies or a moon), except for the January open competition. Every item of the image must be from the submitting photographer.

April 2027—End-of-Year: Up to three images (3) recognized by a judge in the 2026-2027 competitions.

Leisure World of Maryland was set aside for community use and placed in trust, March 9, 1966. By April of 1966, co-operative units were available for occupancy.

In February 1968, Leisure World made a darkroom (in Clubhouse One) available to resident photographers seeking a quiet place to develop and print their camera film.
