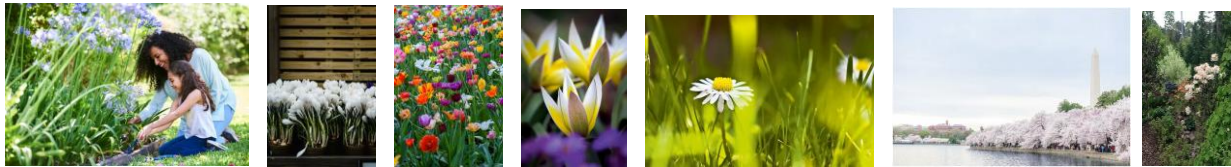


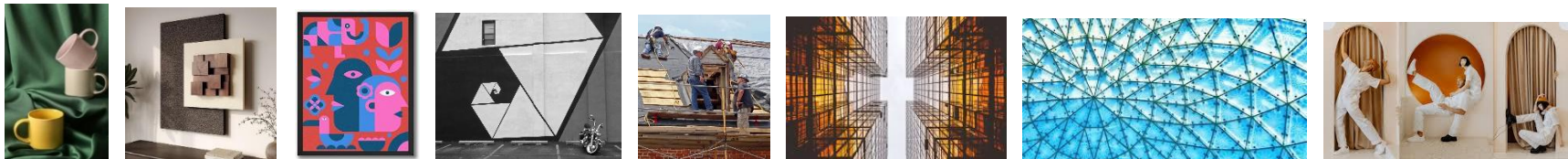
RCC Competition Subjects for 2028 - 2029

September 2028 – Open Subject: Competition open to all images. Post-processing allows for removal of distracting features, e.g., a limb of a tree or a passerby on the edge of the image. However, no new images or significant image elements from another photo, e.g., clouds in the sky, can be added.

October, 2028 - Flora in Spring: Flowers, Trees, and Shrubberty that bloom in the Springtime.

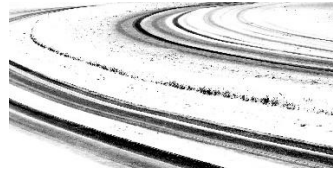


November, 2028 - Geometric Shapes: This subject is limited to photos that emphasize shapes in either two dimensions or three dimensions, e.g., circles, triangles, cones, spheres, cubes, squares, pyramids, hemispheres, prisms, etc.



January 2029 - Open Subject: Advanced techniques allowed, e.g., adding clouds in the sky or cars on a highway. Composite images that include several elements from other photographs, including textures, sky replacement, the moon, etc. may be combined into one image. Every element of the image must be made by the submitting photographer. AI generated images or image elements are not permitted.

February 2029 - Snow Scenes: Use of snow scenes anywhere. The snow should be the most important part of the photograph and not merely the background.



March 2029 - Abandoned and Derelict (not persons or animals): Property which is in a state of obvious disrepair, e.g., sagging roof, peeling paint, door ajar, broken windows, items knocked over or apart, vine covered, mutilated. This subject does not include persons or animals, dead or alive.



April 2029 - End of Year Competition. Up to three images recognized by a judge in the 2028 - 2029 competitions.
